Background

In London, housing prices have gone up by 50% over the last five years. No matter where you live, you and your members are probably feeling the skyrocketing costs of living. More than 65% of CUPE 2361 members work more than one job to make ends meet. Our wages are simply too low. Your membership is likely in a similar boat.

Good jobs are disappearing not only, at Western University, but across our province. Workers' purchasing power has been pushed down. Campus services suffer as recruitment and retention goes down, and workload goes up.

We are part of an increasing wave of union-led collective action to fight back, and the outcome of our fight will affect your local union's negotiations in one way or another. When we stick together, we can all achieve improvements!
